Year 6	Dido Belle and Lord Mansfield		Visits to Kenwood House Workshops on 16 th and 17 th October - How significant was Kenwood, Lord Mansfield and his landmark rulings in the wider abolition movement? Who was Dido Belle? We will need parents to accompany the children on this trip.
