

## **Scope**

This addendum applies until further notice.

Unless covered in this addendum, our normal behaviour policy continues to apply.

We may need to amend or add to this addendum as circumstances or official guidance changes. We will communicate any changes to staff, parents and pupils.

## **Expectations for pupils in school**

### **New rules**

When pupils are in school, we expect them to follow all of the rules set out below to keep themselves and the rest of the school community safe.

Staff will be familiar with these rules and make sure they are followed consistently.

Parents should also read the rules and ensure that their children follow the new procedures that have been put in place. Parents should contact Ms Napthine if they think their child might not be able to comply with some or all of the rules, so we can consider alternative arrangements with them.

Children stay with their own teacher/teaching assistant and do not mix with other children ('bubble' model).

As soon as children arrive at school they will wash their hands. They will wash their hands whenever they leave their classroom and on their return. Children should wash their hands every half hour even if they do not leave their classroom.

Each child will have their own water bottle, which is not to be shared with others.

Each child will be provided with their own pack of tissues. When sneezing or coughing children must be reminded to 'catch it, bin it, kill it' and avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands

Children must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus

Children can only play or do participate in outdoor learning in designated places. These will be shown to the children.

Children are reminded not to cough or spit at or towards any other person.

Outdoor play boxes will only be used by the children in their own bubble.

Children have their own plastic wallet containing their resources. These must not be shared.

Children are expected to follow the one-way system, which will be shown to them on their first day.

Senior leaders and support staff will monitor corridors.

Only one child at a time should be allowed to go to the toilet and if more than one other child is using the toilet they should wait outside until one leaves. Staff on duty will be monitoring the toilets. Toilets will be cleaned regularly.

There will be consequences for children who fail to adhere to these rules.

## **Rewards and sanctions for following rules**

To help encourage pupils to follow the above rules, we will:

Continue to award House Points and follow other reward systems which the class normally uses.

However, if pupils fail to follow these rules, we will follow our Behaviour Jumps. Willful and dangerous behaviour will be treated very seriously.

### **Changed Rules**

As long as this addendum applies, we will alter the following school rule.

- Uniform. Children are not expected to wear school uniform. All clothing should be machine washable and should be washed daily.

### **Monitoring arrangements**

We will review this policy as guidance from the local authority or Department for Education is updated, and as a minimum every 3 to 4 weeks by Ms Wayland (Deputy Headteacher).
