◇ What is a School Governor?

A school governor is someone who helps the school make good decisions for children's learning. Governors do **not** run the school every day – that is the Headteacher's job. Governors help with long-term plans and important choices.

◇ What Do Governors Help With?

- Work with the Headteacher and staff to set the school's goals and priorities
 - Decide how the school budget is used
 - Work with the Headteacher to support the curriculum
 - Agree to school policies and rules
 - Help recruit new school staff
 - Share a yearly report with parents

◇ What Time Do Governors Give?

- Attend governor meetings (6 evening meetings a year, all planned well in advance)
 - Read papers before meetings
 - Join extra meetings or interviews if needed
 - Attend school events
 - Go to training sessions

 - Learn new skills and build confidence
 - Be part of a friendly team
 - Meet new people
 - Help children succeed
 - Feel proud of your contribution
