Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are now fully aware, from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March Colindale Primary School will be re-opening to all children. **All children MUST attend school**, it is compulsory. Following my last letter (26/2/2021) here are a few more reminders of the protocols in place.

### **A staggered start and end to the day – Reception to year 6.**

Children must be dropped off between 8.40 and 9 am and collected between 3.00 and 3.15pm. All three school gates will be open. Children in Years 2 to 4 can be dropped off at the school gates.

### **Independent Travellers – Year 5 and 6**

Children in years 5 and 6 are encouraged to be **independent travellers**. If you would like your child to be an independent traveller, please contact the school office and they can send you a form to complete.

### **Nursery and Little Rainbows**

Drop off and pick-up times: 8.30 to 8.40 and 11.20-11.30; or 12.15-12.25 and 3.00 to 3.15 pm.

### **Trim trail**

This is out of bounds to children before or after school. **Children must not play on the trim trail** at these times to reduce the risk of infection.

### **Swimming and PE**

Both **PE and swimming lessons during the school day will resume** from 8<sup>th</sup> March. Lessons will be on the same day as they were in the Autumn term.

### **School Laptops and books**

If you have borrowed a school laptop you must return it to the school office on 8<sup>th</sup> March. Please also return any school books you have at home - your children can give these directly to their class teacher.
