At Colindale Primary we intend that all key stage 2 children will have the opportunity to learn Spanish in a way that is enjoyable and relevant to their lives. They will gradually acquire a bank of vocabulary centred on everyday topics, such as numbers, colours, body

parts, school, travel and emotions, and learn to use this within simple sentences, both oral and written. The lessons will involve a balance of speaking, listening, reading and writing. The curriculum has been planned so that the teaching in subsequent years builds up on the children's previous knowledge. Lessons will be interactive, fun and stimulating, with vocabulary consolidated through a range of different tasks and activities. Our curriculum is intended to provide a foundation for children who will go on to learn Spanish at secondary school and act as a way for all children to develop a deeper understanding of how languages in general work, which will underpin any other future languages they may learn. Lessons will take place weekly and last for about 30 minutes.

- Make a request in a shop: "I would like...."


Shopping continued:
