Further to yesterday's update the government have extended the advice to people who display either of the following symptoms:-

- A high temperature (37.8 degrees and above)
- A new, continuous cough.

Should your child or any member of your household display either of the above symptoms then the entire household is to self-isolate for 14 days. Do not bring your child to school during this period even if they themselves do not develop either of the above symptoms.
