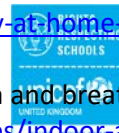
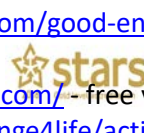

9:45 – 10:00	Handwriting	<p>Practise writing sentences with neat clear handwriting. Letters should be of the correct size. Tall and short letter must be clear as should those letters with a 'tail' such as g or y. Individual lower case letters can be practised in the following order:</p> <p>l, i, u, t, y, j</p> <p>c, o, a, d, g, q</p> <p>n, m, h, k, b, p, r</p> <p>v, w, x, z</p> <p>e, s, f,</p> <p>Practise joining up but only a few words, e.g. short words such as on, at, yes, go, it, van, etc</p> <p><a href="https://www.twinkl.co.uk/">https://www.twinkl.co.uk/</a> - this is a website you can sign up for as it is free for a month.
