## Further update regarding the gradual school re-opening

Since we started to gradually re-open from 8<sup>th</sup> June, the numbers of children in school have steadily increased. We now have 232 children attending in total, from our Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 5 and Year 6, and our Key Worker Bubbles. This coming Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June, we will be welcoming back children in Year 2, which will boost our numbers further.

## **Home Learning Paper Copies**

Children who are attending school are given their home learning paper copies in class to take home. Only children who are NOT coming into school and who need paper copies of work, need to pick up packs. The packs are available from the entrance of the school on Clovelly road every Friday from 1:30 - 3:30 and every Monday from 9:00 - 12:00 and 2.30 – 3.30. We are no longer giving them out on a Monday afternoon or Tuesday morning, as now we have more children in school, the demand has decreased. If you are collecting Home Learning, please only use the Clovelly gate to enter and exit the school.

## **Annual Reports**

Tomorrow (26<sup>th</sup> June) from 9 to 3.30 pm you will be able to collect your child's annual report from school. Children who are attending school will be given their report by their Bubble teacher.
