Step 4 Roadmap guidance from the DfE

Dear parents & carers

As I am sure you are aware, on the 19th July across England, the vast majority of coronavirus restrictions will end. On Tuesday, the Department for Education (DfE) told schools how this will affect us. As the 19th is the last week of term and the children are so used to the routines now and we do not want to confuse them, there are some measures we are going to keep in place until we return in September and a few we will change on that day – see below for details.

Changes in place from Monday 19th July:

1. The one-way system in school that we have had in place since March 2020 will go
2. Bubbles can now mix
3. Parents can attend the Year 6 performances and graduation

Stay the same till September:

1. The start of the day routine
2. The end of the day routine
3. Playtimes
4. Lunchtimes
5. Assemblies
6. Self-isolation after a positive covid case for 10 days
7. Self-isolation with covid symptoms until a test has been shown to be negative
8. Self-isolation if in close contact with a positive case for 10 days
9. Good level of hygiene around the school- extra cleaning of the school and children washing hands frequently
10. Good ventilation – windows and doors open all day
11. Limiting the presence of parents and other visitors in school
