Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 6 children bringing mobile phones to school

At Colindale Primary School we allow year 6 pupils who are independent travellers to bring their mobile phones to school. This ensures that children are able to contact their parents when they are on their way to or from school. Any phones brought in, are left with the teacher at morning registration, or whenever the child arrives at school. The school takes no responsibility for lost or damaged phones.

A number of pupils have smart phones. Please be aware that this type of phone is very attractive to thieves and you may want to consider purchasing a basic phone for your child.

Once your child enters the school site their phone must be switched off and it must not be switched on until they leave through the school gates at the end of the day.

We trust that all pupils who bring their phone to school will act responsibly. Where a pupil has been taking photos or videos of other pupils or teachers, they will be disciplined in accordance with the school behaviour policy and the phone will not be returned until the images have been deleted by the pupil, in the presence of a senior member of staff and the school's computing leader, Mr Dabasia. Pupils who use phones inappropriately will no longer be allowed to bring their phone to school.
