INTERNATIONAL DAY 2019

Wednesday 6th November 2019 is our International Day. On this day all children are invited to wear their traditional/special clothes to school (please ensure sensible footwear is worn). Each year group will spend the afternoon focusing on different activities, celebrating Colindale's diversity.

Nursery and Reception classes will be learning International songs.

Year 1 will be taking part in learning some traditional Chinese dances; writing letters and numbers from many different languages and learning to make an Indian raita dip.

Year 2 will be taking part in learning some traditional Indian dancing; learning to make a Chinese stir fry and creating some Islamic geometric patterns in art.

Year 3 will be asking parents to come in and tell or read stories from their own cultural backgrounds. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you are able to help. The children will also making and comparing international flags.

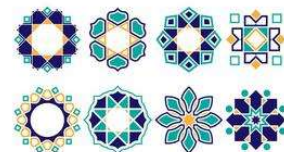
Year 4 will be looking at a Ghanaian story and then making poems, acting and drawing illustrations from it.
