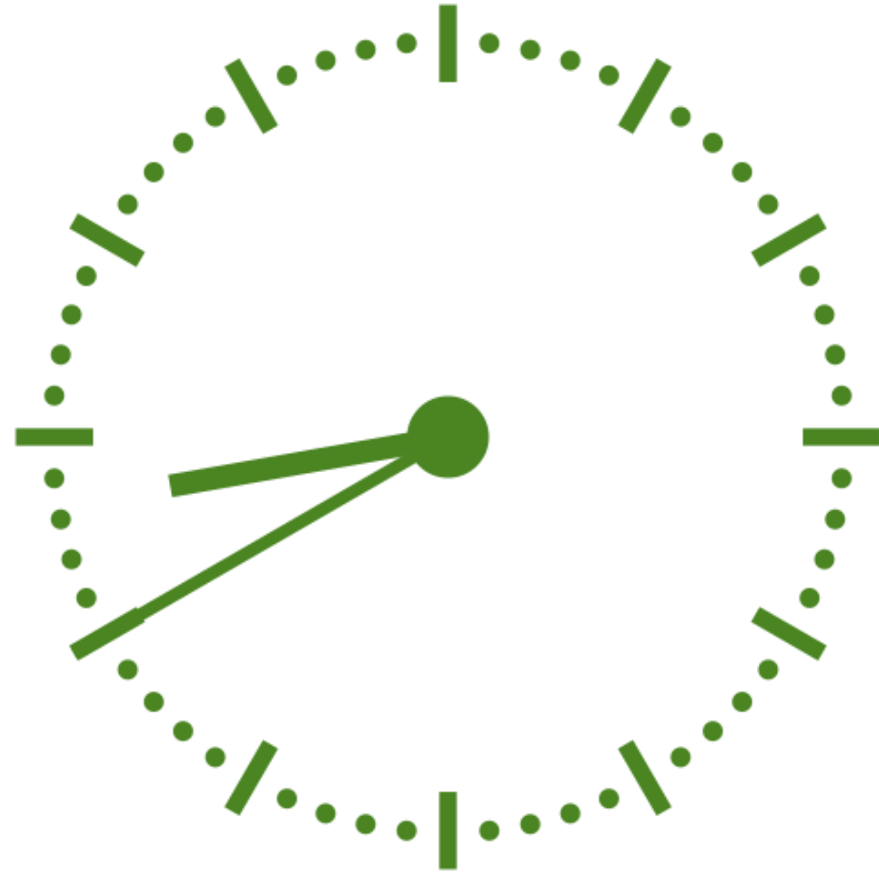

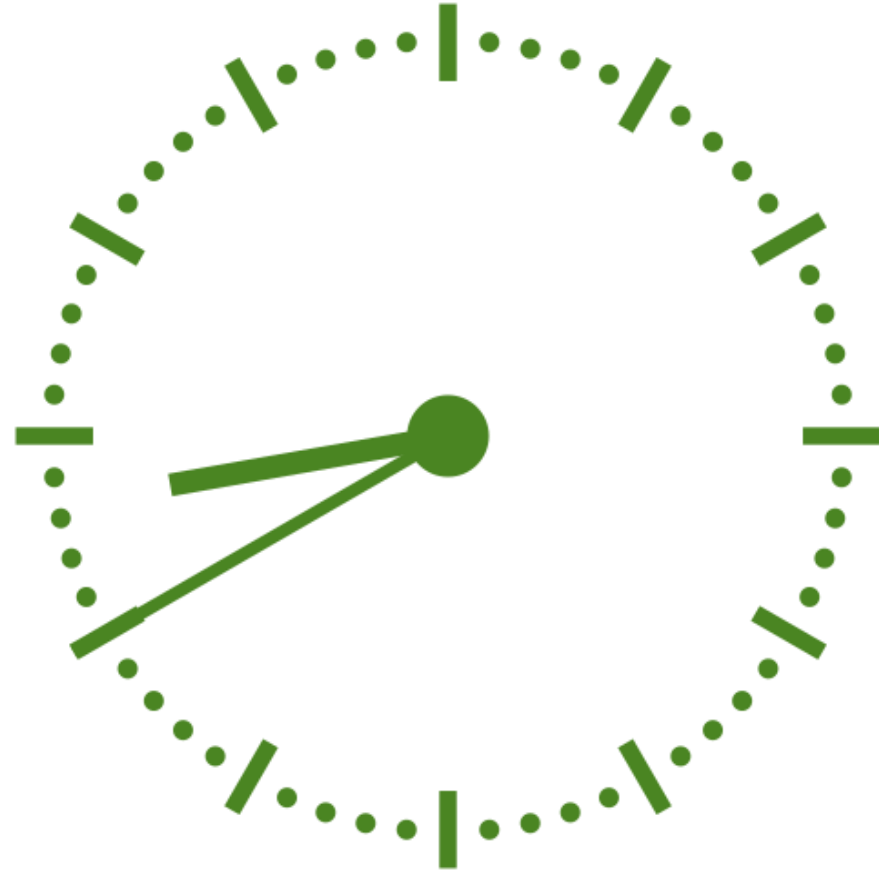

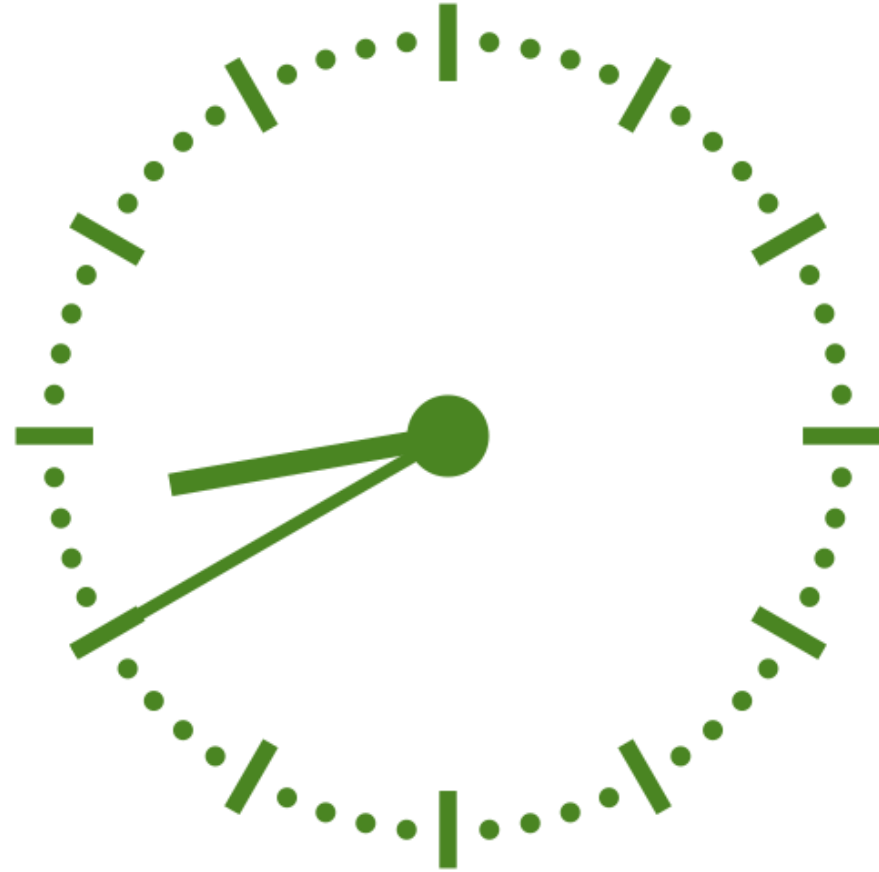

One Way System

There is a one-way system inside the building which must be followed at all times



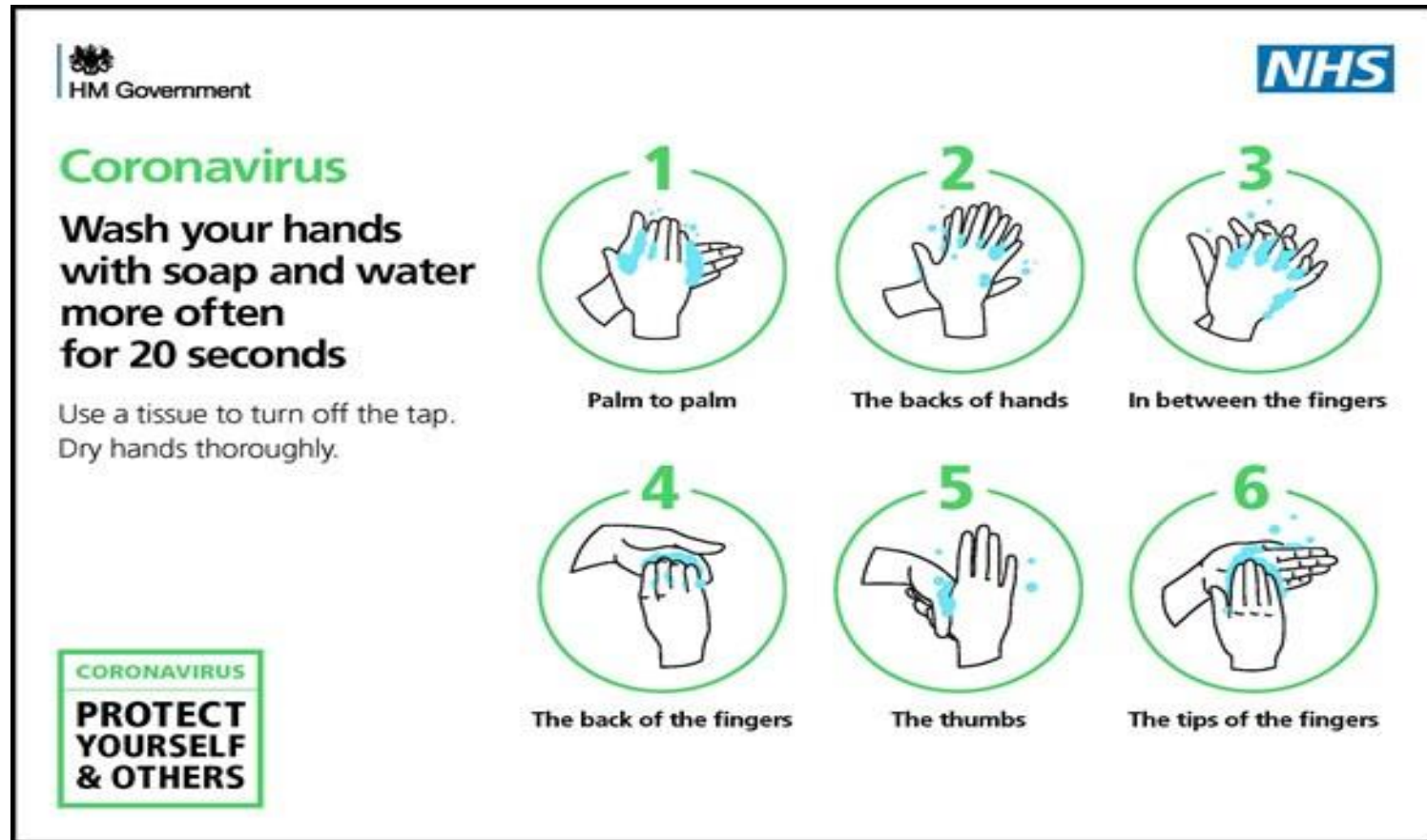
During the school day

- Children will be in class bubbles of 30 for most of the day but have some contact in bigger bubbles of 90 (year groups)

- You will have your personal resource bags – pencils, ruler, pen, rubber, sharpener

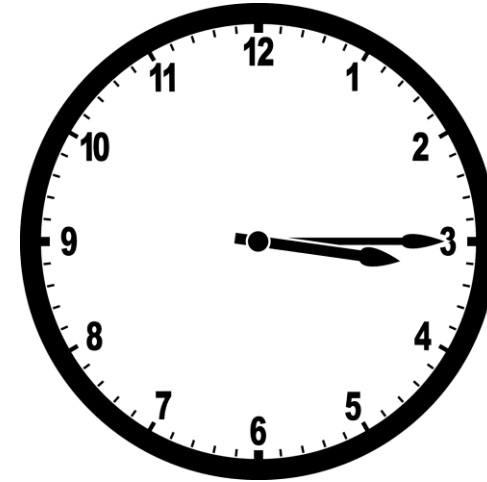
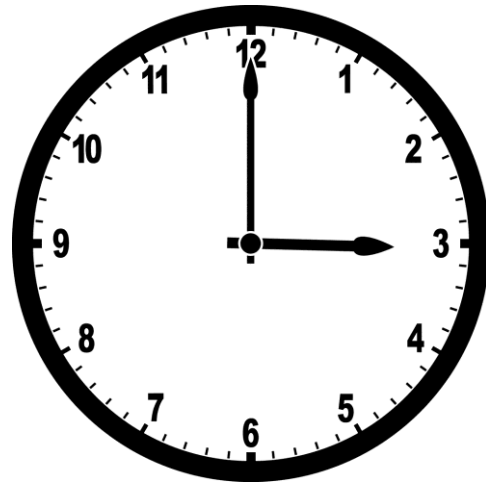
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- All windows and doors where possible will be kept open to ensure good ventilation

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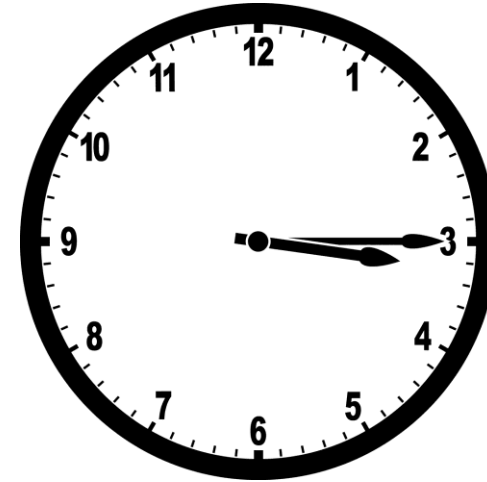
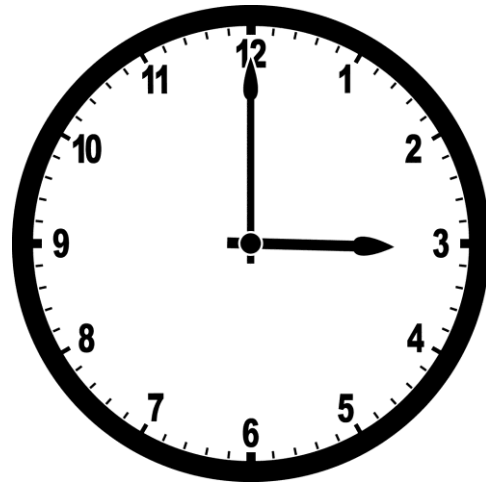
