





One Way System

There is a one-way system inside the building which must be followed at all times












During the school day

• Children will be in class bubbles of 30 for most of the day but have some contact in bigger bubbles of 90 (year groups)



The safety measures currently in place will continue

You must wash your hands before leaving for school, as soon as you arrive in class and many times during the day



There are many sanitisers around the school for you to use throughout the day




You must keep a 2-metre distance from other children and teachers as much as you can




Years 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 will have forward facing desks in your classrooms





You must not be brought to school if you show any signs of coronavirus – cough, temperature, loss of sense of smell or taste





Your parents/carers will book a coronavirus test for you. You can come back to school once you are well


Only one parent will be allowed to take you to and from school

Timetables



There will be some timetable changes

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- PE lessons will take place outside





- All windows and doors where possible will be kept open to ensure good ventilation


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
- You will have your personal resource bags pencils, ruler, pen, rubber, sharpener

- You will be asked to wipe down your laptop when you have finished using it and your book when you have finished reading it








- KS2 classes will have slightly staggered times to have their classrooms






KS2 dismissal areas will be more spread out








- Year 3 will be dismissed from the court closest to the swimming pool one class per side








- KS2 dismissal areas will be more spread out

- Year 4 will be dismissed from the court furthest from the swimming pool one class per side and towards the back end of the court








- KS2 dismissal areas will be more spread out
