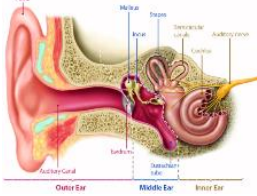


Year 4 Romans Home learning

Find out how ears work. You could create a poster or a PowerPoint Presentation to show your findings.



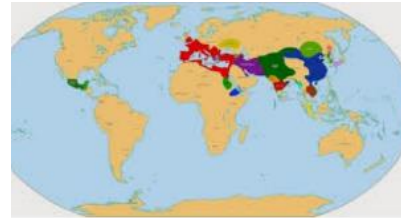
History
