Find out about how your favourite vehicles have changed over time. Draw a timeline to show how a vehicle has changed from when it was first invented to now.



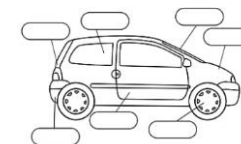
## Geography
