- Remember - holidays should be taken in holiday time and if they are not, parents could face a fine

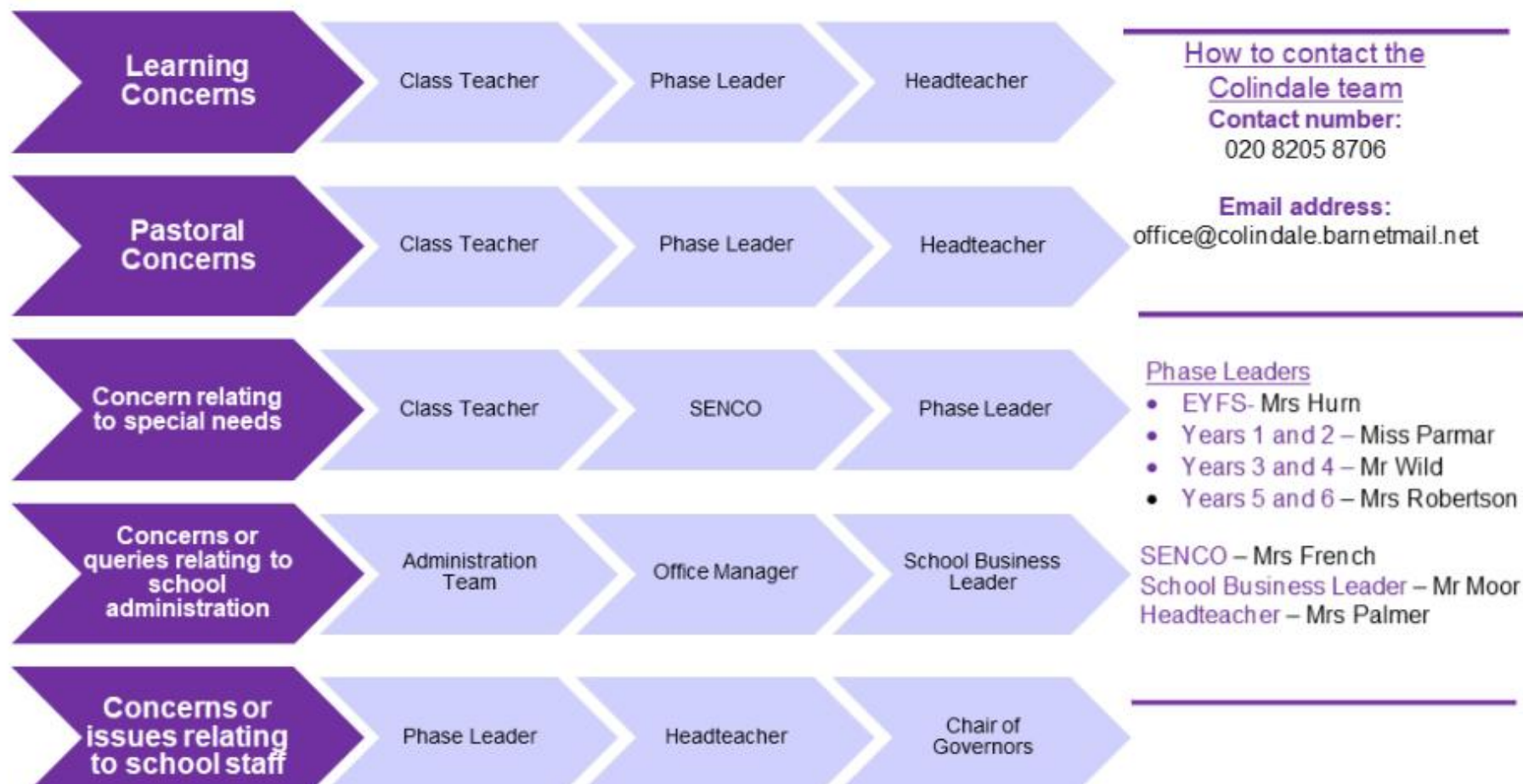
