- Remember - holidays should be taken in holiday time and if they are not, parents can be fined.




Pick up

Children should wear their PE kit to school on their PE days, and they can stay in their kit.


Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

- Statutory assessments for all Year 4 children
- Aim is for all children to know their times tables up to 12 by the end of Year 4
- Last year they were set for early June, likely to be similar again
- Assessment consists of 25 questions, 6 seconds per question
