Uniform



- It is very important that your child has the correct uniform and that all of it is labelled with names and classes.
- PE kits should consist of:
 - Black jogging bottoms/ leggings
 - White t-shirt
 - Black or white plimsolls/trainers for outside
- If your child's class has PE as the first session of the day, the children may come dressed in their PE kits, but will need to have their school uniform as well.

Home Learning

- Daily reading - either the guided reading book from school, library book or any other book from home.
- Research into topics studied
- Daily timestables
- 15 minutes daily mental maths activities
- e.g. number bonds, doubles, halves, times tables practise, dividing, reading the time
- Practise spellings from the Year 4 spelling list or spelling list appropriate to your child
