Science

History

Find out about animals that have been extinct.



Draw a picture of your chosen animal and write information about it.

Geography



Research what animals are found in the country you come from. Find this country on a world map and draw a picture of these animals.



Art

Trace a picture of an animal and use the three primary colours (red, yellow and blue) to paint it.



DT

Make an animal using vegetables. Can you bring it in or take a picture of your creation?



Computing

Paint – Drawing on the computer

Draw a picture of your favourite animal.



Add as much detail as you can using different colours and different tools. Add some labels that describe different aspects about your animal, such as, where they live and what they eat.

RE

Some animals are sacred in different religions. Find out what animals are special in the religion of Hinduism and write some sentences about them.
