

# Year 2 Famous People Home Learning Activities

## Science

Research a famous doctor or nurse. Make a poster about them and include some interesting facts.



## History

Pretend that you are Florence Nightingale, helping soldiers in the Crimean War. Write a letter home explaining what is happening to the soldiers and how you are helping.



## Geography

Choose a famous explorer to research. Make a poster about them and include interesting facts.



## Art

Research the famous artist Andy Warhol. Getting inspired by his art, use your handprints to imitate his work.



## DT

Create a fun game that teaches others important facts about famous people. Include your favourite famous people and interesting facts about them.



## Computing

Paint or other drawing software. Draw a picture on the computer of a famous person that you know. You can use your mouse, mouse pad or your finger if you have a tablet or iPad. Remember to use different colours and different tools.



## RE

Find out about the famous founder of Sikhism, Guru Nanak. Create a poster about him using pictures and interesting facts.



## PSHE

What can you do to manage your feelings? Make a list e.g. Talk to a trusted adult



## PE

Listen to the music below and create a sequence of movements to create a dance.



Think about how the animals move and listen carefully to the speed of the music.

Try and use different levels whilst performing each movement, e.g. high, middle, low.
