Science

Investigate materials at home. Find out what different objects in your home are made of. Can you change the shape of these objects by twisting or pulling them?



History

Write a newspaper report about The Great Plague.

THE GREAT PLAGUE OF LONDON 1665 – 1666



Geography

Find out where London is on a world map and label countries near it.



Art

Create a painting by pulling paint up the paper. Then cut out houses and stick on top. If they go wrong don't worry they look like houses which are falling down.

Use junk modelling to make a house from 1666. You can add flames to it so that it looks like it is on fire!

WORD. Create a poster about the famous buildings in London. Copy and paste pictures on to WORD. Make sure each picture has a title and an explanation.

Visit a special place of worship in your local area in London and find out some facts about it.
