Science

On a sunny day, get someone to draw around your shadow every hour. Think about how the shadow has changed and why. You could make a poster, a PowerPoint presentation or a leaflet about what you find out.



History

Create a little book, or poster about your family history. Where do your family come from? Why did they move? What was it like when your different family members were young?



Geography

Find out about the traditional food found in the country you and/or your parents come from.



Art

Create a factsheet/poster about your home country. Don't forget to add your country's name and flag.



DT

Research facts on a famous chef and re-create one of his/her dishes. Don't forget to take a picture and tell your class about your chosen chef.

RE

PSHE

Write a list of the people you could go to if you ever needed help. Think about why these people are safe people to go to for you. You could draw a picture of these people and label qualities they have which makes them people you can trust e.g. trustworthy, kind

Practice a short sequence of movements, e.g. balance, rolls, jumps. Think about making your starting and finishing positions really clear. Ensure all movements are controlled and clear.
