<p><b><u>Monday</u></b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Write a play script-Scene 3</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Read the beginning of Scene 3 from "The story of Osiris".</b> <u>Scene 3 –Isis finds Osiris</u></p> <p><b>Characters:</b> Isis, Seth, Narrator</p> <p>(Isis enters the stage. She is crying.)</p> <p><b>Isis</b> (Hold your head, cry): What have you done to my husband, Seth? Where is Osiris? <b>Seth</b> (Grin, speak in a loud voice): Where he belongs. At the bottom of the river Nile! <b>Isis:</b> Oh, no! I must go and find him. <b>Narrator:</b> Isis walked and walked for miles before she ...</p> <p><b>Finish Scene 3 (the third/fourth paragraph in the story - up until Seth cuts up the body) and draw a picture that shows what is happening.</b></p>
<p><b><u>Tuesday</u></b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Write a play script-Scene 4</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Read the beginning of Scene 4 from "The story of Osiris".</b> <u>Scene 4 - Osiris' Burial</u></p> <p><b>Characters:</b> Narrator, Isis, Anubis</p> <p><b>Narrator:</b> Isis did not give up. She walked for miles picking up each piece.</p> <p><b>Isis</b> (Hold the pieces of the body and kneel): I have all the pieces of my beloved husband. I will call Anubis to help me. Anubis! (shouting) Anubis, please, I need your help. <b>Narrator:</b> Anubis, the God of mummification, heard Isis cries and appeared in front of her. (Anubis enters the stage.) <b>Anubis:</b> ...</p> <p><b>Finish Scene 4 (the fifth paragraph in the story - up until Anubis brings Osiris to life) and draw a picture that shows what is happening.</b></p>
<p><b><u>Wednesday</u></b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Write a play script-Scene 5</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Read the rest of the story (until the end) and write the last scene.</b> Scene 5 - (Write a title for Scene 5)</p> <p><b>Characters:</b> (Write the characters)</p> <p><b>Narrator:</b> Osiris was given a proper burial and lived in the underworld. Isis had a beautiful baby boy. (Isis enters the stage holding a baby in her arms.) <b>Isis:</b> ....</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Draw a picture that shows what is happening.</b></p>
<p><b><u>Thursday</u></b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Act out your play script</u></b></p>

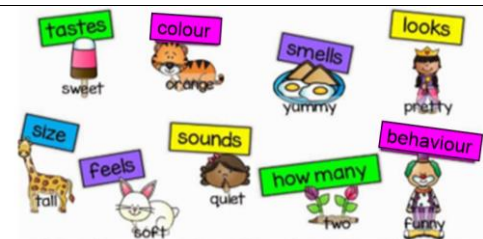

### Verbs and Adjectives

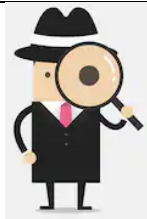


A **VERB** is a word that tells about an action or a state.

It is the main part of a sentence: every sentence has a **verb**.



An **ADJECTIVE** is a word that is used to help describe or give description to people, places, and things.
