This leaflet tells you what your child will be learning this term. We really value the help that you can give your child with their learning and self-help skills.

Please take the time to teach your child to:

- dress/undress themselves
- fasten their own coat
- use a knife and fork
- use the toilet properly, flushing the toilet and washing and drying their own hands
- use a tissue to wipe their own nose and to throw the tissue into the bin
- tidy up their own toys
- say "please" and "thank you"

Please also try to spend more time talking with your child. Reducing the time spent watching television and/or playing on a tablet will help your child develop better speaking and listening skills.

Skills we will be focusing on indoors and outdoors

Communication and Language



- Listen to others one to one or in small group conversations
- Follow simple instructions
- Talk about experiences and ideas with others
- Find out about new words
- Join in with rhymes and stories
- Asking questions

Personal, Social and Emotional Development



- Making friends, learning to play co-operatively
- Sharing and taking turns
- Talking about feelings
- Learning and following the class rules
- Becoming independent, choosing activities independently
- Tidying up after themselves
- Developing self-confidence to speak in a group

Physical Development



Gross motor skills:

- Running, jumping, hopping, skipping, balancing and climbing
- Basic ball skills

Fine motor skills:

- Using the tripod pencil grip
- Pencil control
- **Cutting with scissors**
- Threading





Literacy




- Listening to stories, looking at books together
- Developing an awareness of rhyme e.g. cat, mat, hat
- Knowing the first sounds in words e.g. dog, book
- Recognising and writing their names
- Writing lower case letters
- Phase 1 phonics: hearing and saying sounds in words e.g. p-i-n, s-a-t
- Phase 2 phonics: recognising letters and their sounds
- Recognising tricky words

Maths



- Recognise numbers 0-10, then 0-20 Count objects 1-10, then 1-20
- Comparing groups of objects, knowing *more* or *fewer*
- Naming basic 2D shapes e.g. square, triangle, circle
- Using shape language e.g. round, straight, tall
- Use positional language e.g. in, on, under, over, behind





- Creating models and collages using different tools and materials

- Explore their environment with enthusiasm and independence
- Concentrate on their activities for longer periods of time
- Keep on trying when they come across a problem
- Use their imagination and talk about what they are thinking
- Try different methods if things don't work the first time
