Year 4 Curriculum Overview Autumn term 2019 Class 4B, 4J and 4R



This information tells you what your child will be learning this term in school. We really value your support and the help that you can give your child with their learning.

The curriculum

Our focus this term in English:

- 'The Lost Happy Ending'- descriptive fantasy story to use as a model for writing their own story.
- Newspapers and Magazines Creating a news article about a Roman event.
- Creating their own fantasy/adventure stories for their class animations.
- Plays Reading, writing and performing play scripts.

In Maths we will be learning to:

- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits, using the formal written methods of column addition and subtraction where appropriate.
- Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation.
- Solve addition and subtraction two step problems in contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why.

The topic in the 1st half of term is the Romans:

- In History we will be learning about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain, contrasting Ancient Roman times with present day and looking at the power of the Roman army and Boudicca's rebellion.
- In Geography we will be locating the Roman Empire and developing our map reading skills using globes, atlases and maps.
- In Science we will be learning about how sound is made and received by the ear.
- In Art we will be developing our collage skills with a range of collage techniques such as tearing, overlapping and layering, to create images and represent textures.
- In **RE**, we will be learning about the places of worship for Christianity, Islam and Buddhism and activities that occur there.
- In Music we will be learning to sing with expression and use repeated patterns in rhythms.
- In **PSHCE** we will be learning about different types of relationships- e.g. friendships, family, neighbours, and developing their vocabulary to describe their emotions









- In Spanish we will be learning numbers to 30 and body parts
- In computing we will be using Scratch to learn basic coding
- In **PE** we will be developing longer, more complex dance phrases

The topic in the 2nd half of term is Lights, Camera, Action!

- In **Science** we will be learning about electricity and how to make an electrical circuit to light a bulb, using a switch.
- In Art/DT we will be creating a 3D scene using plasticine, cardboard, paper and other media, including electricity
- In **Computing** we will have a visiting animation specialist using 'I stop Motion' programming with voice recordings to re-enact children's stories. Completed work will be published on You Tube
- In **Music** we will be learning to recognise and identify instruments, numbers of instruments and voices being played and create sound effects for animations.
- In **PSHCE** we will be learning about paying for goods in a range of ways and how to keep simple financial records; making choices on spending and saving.
- In **Spanish** we will be learning numbers from 31-100, dates and Christmas vocabulary.
- RE as above
- In **PE** we will extend dance sequences and suggest how performances can be improved
